Na die vernietigende uitwerking van die Covid-19 pandemie vanaf 2019-2022, is die kerkgemeenskap stadig maar seker weer besig om kop op te tel. Ons het so verlang na die heerlike geselligheid in ons tradisionele geloofsgemeenskappe.

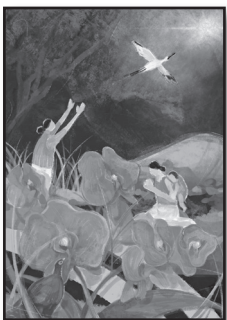
Die tema vir Wêreldbiddag 2023 spoor ons aan om ons geloof in Christus opnuut te bevestig en te bely. Ons Hemelse Vader bemoedig en spoor ons aan: "Daarom, vandat ek gehoor het van julle geloof in die Here Jesus en van julle liefde vir al die gelowiges, hou ek ook nie op om God vir julle te dank nie." (Efesiërs 1:15-16). Kom ons fokus en wy ons toe om God nie teleur te stel nie, maar ons geloof te laat groei en mekaar te versterk.

Die program vir die diens is deur Taiwan, onder leiding van die Internasionale Komitee, saamgestel. Die Programkomitee van Suid-Afrika het dit vir Suidelike Afrika se unieke omstandighede aangepas, en dit word in 8 van ons amptelike tale vertaal. Die program dien as riglyn in die beplanning van die aanbiddingsgeleentheid. Dit is nie 'n rigiede program nie, en jy is welkom om aanpassings te maak om die styl van aanbidding, liedere en behoeftes in jou omgewing te akkommodeer.

- *Kyk na die Voorbereidings op p. 3 van die Program.*
- *Deel by die deure 'n kaartjie vir elke vrou uit om gedurende Refleksie/ Nadenke te gebruik.*
- *Tafel in die Liturgiese area: Versier die tafel met 'n blou tafeldoek, (Taiwan word deur die oseaan omring), 'n groen doek, wat die bergpieke voorstel, 'n geel en 'n wit doek, wat die natuurlike hulpbronne voorstel.*
- *Versier die tafel met lelies en orgideë of vou papierblomme, asook 'n Bybel, oop by Ef. 1:15-19.*
- *Plaas 'n kaart van Taiwan in die vorm van 'n legkaart op die tafel.*
- *Maak die storie lewendig in jul eie konteks, en laat elkeen na binne kyk en haar geloof in God evalueer.*
- *Ruim genoeg geleentheid vir persoonlike, sowel as behoeftes van die gemeenskap, in gedurende Spontane Gebed.*
- *Die Power Point en Musiek-CD is beskikbaar om ekstra agtergrond en atmosfeer aan die diens te verleen.*

Die vroue sit in stil gebed by 'n stroompie, terwyl hul opkyk na die donkerte. Ten spyte van die onbekende pad wat voorlê, weet hul dat hul Verlossing in Christus lê.

Twee bedreigde spesies word uitgebeeld: die *Mikado-pheasant* en die *Blackfaced Spoonbill*.

Die groen gras en skoenlaper-orgideë staan uit teen die donker agtergrond. Die groen gras simboliseer die Taiwanese bevolking as eenvoudig, selfversekerd, sterk en onder God se sorg.

All over the world (176 regions and countries) the same theme is observed, together with the order of service. The golden thread of our Salvation through Jesus Christ is therein confirmed, no matter in which part of the world we live, or whatever language is spoken. It is amazing to be part of this chain of prayer.

Thank you for organizing the worship service for 2023 in your local church or community. The past two years have been extremely challenging for South Africa. After the Covid-19 pandemic hit the world so unexpectedly in 2019/2020, the church community slowly but surely started lifting our heads again. We longed for the wonderful sociability of our traditional faith community.

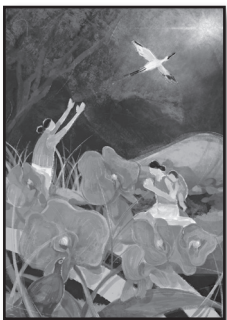
The WDP 2023 theme encourages us to renew and reconcile our faith in Jesus Christ. Our Heavenly Father urges and encourages us: "For this reason, ever since I heard about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all God's people, I have not stopped giving thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers." (Ephesians 1:15-16) Let us focus and commit ourselves to not disappoint God, but to feed and strengthen our faith.

The worship booklet is a resource material and is compiled by the writer country (Taiwan) under the guidance of the International Committee. It is adapted for Southern Africa's environment by the South African Program Committee. The program is translated into eight of the official languages spoken in South Africa. The program is a support to putting together the worship service. Feel free to shorten the program to the style of worship and needs of your local community.

SUGGESTIONS ON THE PRESENTATION OF THE THEME, "I have heard about your faith":

- Look at the "Preparation" on p3 of the Worship Service.
- Hand out a card to each member for use during Reflection.
- Table in the Worship area: Cover it with a blue cloth (Taiwan is surrounded by the ocean), a green cloth, that symbolizes the mountains, a yellow and white cloth, as a symbol for the natural resources.
- Decorate the table with lilies and orchids or fold paper flowers, as well as a Bible, opened at Ephesians 1:15-19.
- Place a map of Taiwan, in the form of a puzzle on the table.
- Bring the story alive in your own context, and let everybody reflect on her own faith in God.
- Create enough opportunity for personal or local prayer during Spontaneous Prayers.
- The Power point and Music CD are available to give extra background and atmosphere to the service.
